24th World Scout Jamboree - North America, West Virginia

Following a recent application process and assessment day of over two thousand of applicants; I have been very lucky to have been selected as one of the two Scouts to represent Mansfield & District Scouting as part of the International Service Team within the UK contingent at The World Scout Jamboree in North America, West Virginia. The jamboree itself is being held at the Summit Bechtel Family National Service Reserve. This will be a once in a lifetime trip and learning opportunity for myself and the other participants.

Between 22nd July and 2nd August 2019, over 30,000 young people and adult volunteers are expected to attend from 150 countries in the largest event being held in scouting worldwide to date. The theme of the jamboree will be "unlock a new world", the theme speaks to the new adventures, cultures and friendships that will be shared by scouts from around the world during the 12-day event. A theme I am excited to vouch for during my time in America.

The cost for each UK Contingent Member as International Service Team to attend the jamboree is £2995 however, as there has been two members selected from Mansfield in total we need to raise £5990. As part of our learning, those chosen to attend are expected to raise funds to pay for the life changing experience. This in itself is a great challenge but it will allow for members to network within the community and with local businesses to develop contacts whilst creating new friendships and bonds facing these new adventures. Some of the essential themes of the jamboree and we only have just over a year to raise the funds required.
